ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, namely, James R. Scott, of Washington, D. C.; Harvey Edson Rogers, of Washington, D. C.; Daniel K. Nicola, of Washington, D. C.; Arthur G. Takoma Park, Md.; and Amos P. Needham, of Washington, D. C., being of full age, and citizens of the United States, and who are residents of the District of Columbia, do hereby unite ourselves together to form a corporation, the objects hereinafter set out, in pursuance of the acts of Congress, approved March 3, 1879, and acts of Congress, for ourselves, our heirs, assigns, and successors, to make, sign, and acknowledge this instrument, and to record, shall constitute the after-named corporation.

Name. The name of the corporation shall be "General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists."

II—Duration. The corporation is organized and the duration of its existence is to be perpetual.

III—Objects. The objects of the corporation shall be to publish, circulate, and distribute the "Review and Herald" and other publications; to receive and hold property for the purpose of carrying into effect the objects of the corporation; to make loans; to acquire, possess, and hold real and personal property; to make deposits of money; to issue bonds and notes; to acquire, possess, and hold mixed estates in this or foreign countries; to receive, hold, and dispose of property by gift, bequest, devise, or purchase, and to sell, and convey the same by instrument of security or conveyance as may be required; and to do all such other things as may be necessary to carry into effect the objects of the corporation, and to do all such other things as may be necessary to carry into effect the objects of the corporation.


